GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

**And now, O Israel,
what does
the LORD your God
ask of you**

GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

**but to fear
the LORD your God,**

**A “reverential, respectful, and awestruck fear” of
God.**

GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

to walk in all his ways,

**Because Israel belonged to God,
she, as a nation was to act and follow God.**

GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

to love him,

**Love Jesus with all your heart because Jesus loves
you with all His heart!!**

GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

**to serve the LORD your God with all your heart
and with all your soul,**

**As Christians we are to act as the children of
God and make our Father prouder of us.
(He's already "proud" of us!!)**

GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

and to observe

**the LORD's commands and decrees that I am
giving you today**

**We should live out these verses in our lives
today under the Power of God's Holy Spirit.**

GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

for your own good?

It's for "your" own good.....

His will is good, pleasing, and perfect!!

GOODNESS FOR GOD

Vss. 12-13

Here we are reminded of Micah 6:8:

**He has showed you,
O man, what is good.**

**And what does the LORD require of you? To act
justly and to love mercy and to
walk humbly with your God.**

THE GRACE OF GOD

Vss. 14-16

**To the LORD your God belong the heavens, even
the highest heavens, the earth and everything
in it.**

Everything is His.....

THE GRACE OF GOD

Vss. 14-16

**Yet the LORD
set his affection
on your forefathers
and loved them,**

His first love is His people!!

THE GRACE OF GOD

Vss. 14-16

**and he chose you, their descendants,
above all the nations, as it is today.**

**God chose Israel above all nations.....
to display His splendor and power among the
“least of the nations”.**

THE GRACE OF GOD

Vss. 14-16

**Circumcise your hearts, therefore, and do not be
stiff-necked
any longer.**

**Israel was the most rebellious, stiff-necked
nation. God wanted to refine them so He
could be glorified through them.**

THE GRACE OF GOD

Vss. 14-16

- **God has chosen you and I above all people, if we are born again Christians (born of His Spirit).**
- **It is us who are the children of God if we have believed Christ for His shed blood on the cross for the forgiveness of sins (washed in His blood).**

THE GRACE OF GOD

Vss. 14-16

- **And have believed that His resurrection from the dead assures us of eternal life in Him.**
- **We did nothing to deserve this.**
- **It is all God's grace, unmerited favor.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**For the LORD your God is
God of gods
and Lord of lords,
the great God,**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**mighty and awesome, who shows
no partiality
and accepts no bribes.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**He defends
the cause
of the fatherless
and the widow,**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**and loves the alien, giving him
food and clothing.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**And you are to love those who are aliens,
for you yourselves were aliens in Egypt.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**Fear the LORD
your God
and serve him.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**Hold fast to him
and take your oaths
in his name.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**He is your praise;
he is your God,**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**who performed for you those great
and awesome wonders
you saw with your own eyes.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**Your forefathers
who went down
into Egypt
were seventy in all**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**and now
the Lord your God
has made you
as numerous
as the stars in the sky.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

- **Israel had experienced God's greatness.**
- **As a result, Israel was to be motivated to behave as God would have her to behave.**

THE GREATNESS OF GOD

Vss. 17-21

**Because of God's greatness to us, we too, should
be motivated to behave like His children and
make Him**

EVEN PROUDER OF US!!!
